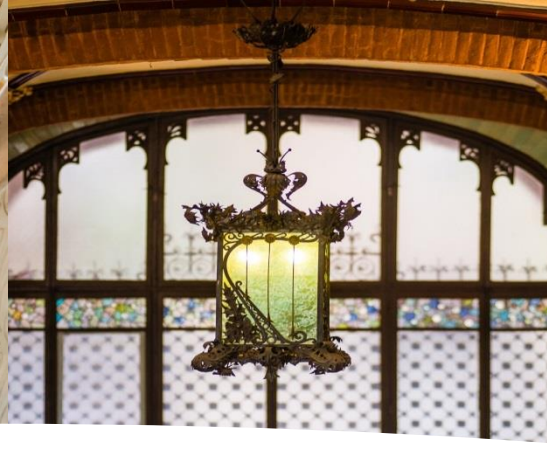

The result of Renaissance, Modernism, or Catalan Art Nouveau, largely determines the personality of Barcelona.

Architecture, together with the applied arts, constituted the most unique and valued form of expression of Modernisme, both in terms of civic and industrial construction. A style where the curve predominates on the straight, the asymmetry, the decoration detail with the use of plant, natural and female figures.

Modernist architecture in Catalonia means, on the one hand, the modernization of construction techniques (use of iron in structures, use of prefabricated elements), while conserving traditional elements (buildings with brickwork) and linking them with Gothic style with which it has a certain parallelism. It is a decorative, integrative architecture in the building of all the plastic arts.

The Barcelona Pass Modernista has been designed to give visitors a greater insight into the Catalan art nouveau, Modernisme, away from the major landmarks.

It will help to discover the least-known works of the world-renowned architects and other gems of this artistic movement.

This product is the best solution to reach Montserrat without a guided tour. This all-in-one ticket allows to use all the public transportation. The train reaches Monistrol de Montserrat, at the foot of the mountain and leaves from plaça Espanya which is served by the metro network. Once reached the foothills of Montserrat you can get to the top on the rack railway, the **Cremallera**, which opened in the 19th century and has recently been refurbished, or by the cable car, the **Aeri**, which scales gradients of up to 45%. In both cases, you'll enjoy a journey with spectacular panoramic views until you get to Montserrat.

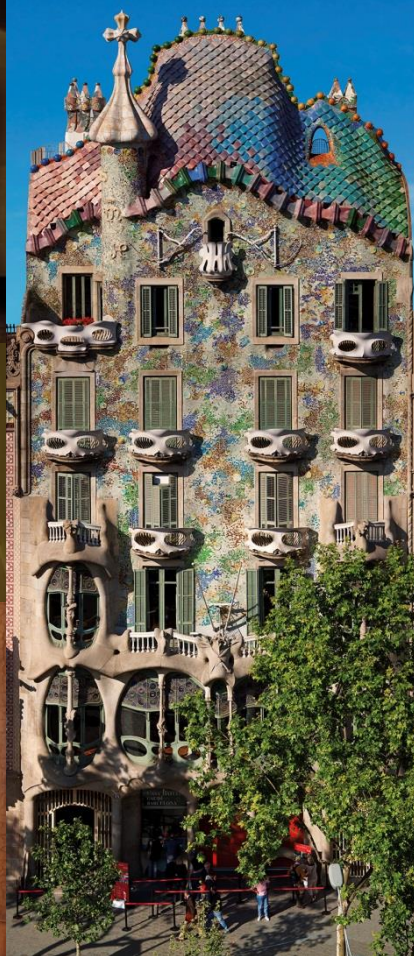

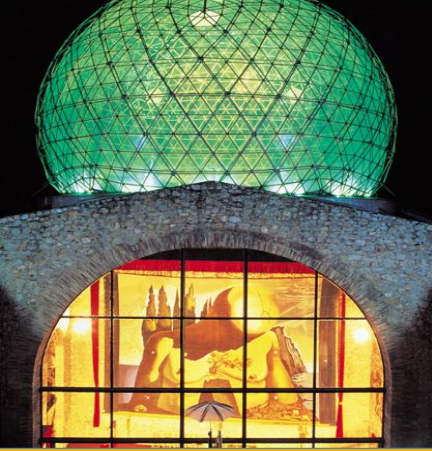

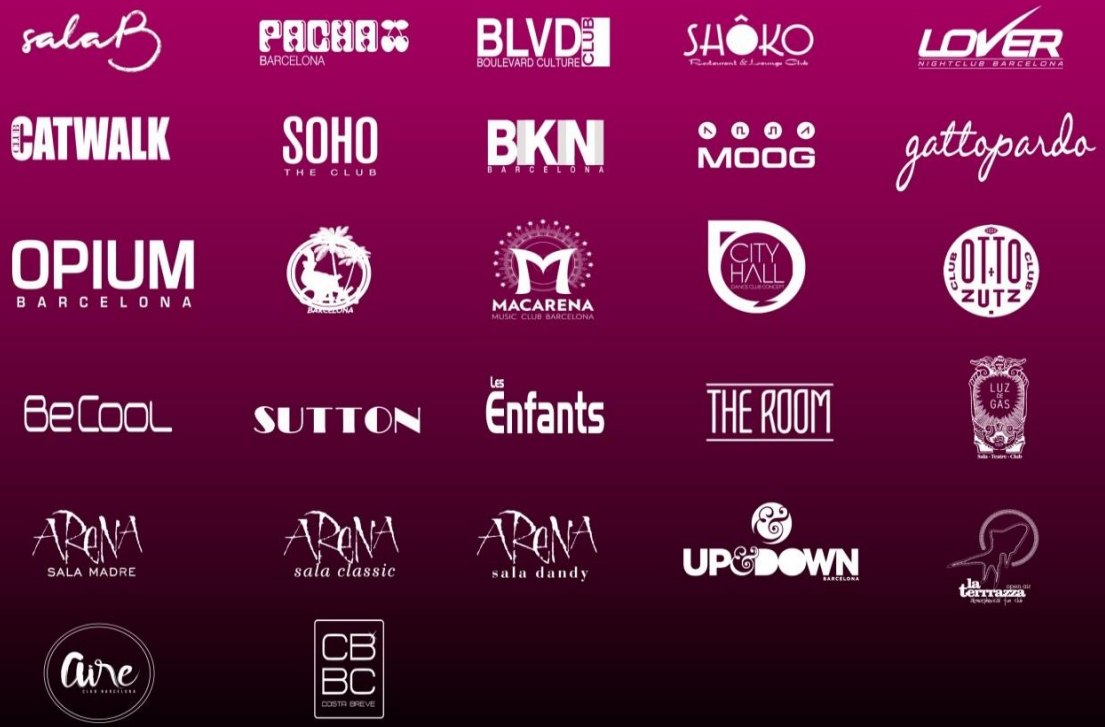
