## Go Boston Explorer included attractions

### 1. Freedom Trail® Official Public Walking Tour

Professionally-guided 90-minute public walking tour that covers many of the 16 historic Freedom Trail sights.

**Duration:** Approximately 1.5 hours.

**Getting In:** Tour schedule is subject to change. We suggest you call or visit [TheFreedomTrail.org](http://TheFreedomTrail.org) for the current tour schedule prior to your Freedom Trail experience. Monday – Wednesday Tours: present your pass at the Boston Common Visitor Information Center. Walk Into History® Tours may depart daily at 11:00am, 12:00 noon, 1:00pm, 2:00pm (mid-April – November only), 3:00pm (mid-April – November only) & 4:00pm (mid-April – November only). Thursday – Sunday Tours (booth closes at 3:00pm on Sundays): present your pass at the ArtsBoston BosTix Booth–Faneuil Hall. Walk Into History® Tours may depart daily at: 10:30am, 11:30am, 12:30pm & 3:30pm. North End Tours may depart at: 1:30pm & 2:30pm (mid-April – November); and (July – August) Pirates & Patriots® Tour departs: Saturdays & Sundays at: 1:00pm.

**Notes:** Reservations are required if you are traveling with a group of 10 or more and these groups will be split up to experience tours at different times, based upon availability. Please call ahead to make arrangements. Specialty tours such as the Historic Holiday Stroll and Historic Pub Crawl are not included. However, if you are interested in taking the Pirates & Patriots Tour or the North End Tour instead of the Walk Into History Tour, your Go Boston Explorer pass will be honored at the ArtsBoston BosTix Booth location only (Tuesday – Sunday from mid-April – November). Gratuity for guides is appreciated and not included with Go Boston Explorer pass admission. Pass is accepted on public walking tours only. Private tours are not included.

### 2. CityView Hop-On Hop-Off Boston Trolley Sightseeing Tour: 1-Day Ticket

1-Day sightseeing trolley pass.

**Duration:** Approximately 1-2 hours (without hopping-off).

**Getting In:** Please present your pass at the CityView Trolley booth located at the front of the Marriott Long Wharf building (corner of Atlantic Ave. and State St). The CityView Trolley representative will scan your pass and give you your Trolley ticket.

**Notes:** The hop-on hop-off sightseeing trolley tour is a great way to get acquainted with the city, but should not be

relied on as a mode of transportation. For quickest transportation between attractions, we recommend you take the “T”.

**Hours:** January – March: generally weekends only: 9:30am – 3:30pm. From March 16: daily: 9:30am – 3:30pm. (Available for school vacation week from February 17-25, weather permitting.) April – August: daily: 9:30am – 5:00pm. September – November: daily: 9:30am – 4:30pm. December: Friday – Monday: 9:30am – 3:30pm.

**Duration:** Approximately 2 hours.

**Getting In:** Skip the general ticketing line by presenting your pass at the Information Desk located inside the front doors of the Aquarium. They will scan your pass and give you a ticket for entry.

**Notes:** The Aquarium is wheelchair and stroller accessible. Go Boston Explorer pass admission applies only to the New England Aquarium. IMAX and Whale Watch tickets are available for an additional charge. Special Offer: Save \$1.00 on your purchase of any of the New England Aquarium’s exciting IMAX movies, shown on the largest IMAX screen in New England!

Movies currently playing feature a variety of different creatures and are sure to appeal to the whole family. All films are in 3D and have a running time of 40 minutes. Visit the New England Aquarium website for a list current films and showtimes.

## 6. Boston Duck Tour

Tour admission.

**Duration:** Approximately 1.5 hours.

**Getting In:** There are two easy ways to book a tour:

**1. By phone:** up to 30 days in advance at (617) 450-0068 (subject to a booking fee per person, see below).

Prudential Center departures: \$5 booking fee per person.

New England Aquarium departures: \$5 booking fee per person.

Museum of Science departures: special – only a \$1 booking fee per person!

If booking your tour in advance by phone, your credit card will be charged the full retail rate of the tour, plus the applicable booking fee per person (as noted above). When you have presented your valid pass at the departure point, your credit card will be reimbursed in full, less the booking fee (you do not need to have your credit card with you). All bookings are nonrefundable and non-exchangeable.

**2. In person:** at the departure locations (same day bookings only, no fee).

Tip: Tours sell out early during the summer season. We suggest that you arrive early in the day to make any same-day reservations.

**Getting In:** Present your pass at the Boston Duck Tours booth or wagon at the departure location.

**Notes:** Children under the age of 3 who do not have a pass will be required to pay for admission to the Boston Duck Tours directly. As of this printing, the “under 3” rate is \$10.50, but is subject to change.

**Hours: Prudential Center:** March 21 – December 1: daily: 9:00am – one hour before sunset. December 6 – December 22: Friday, Saturday & Sunday: 9:00am – 3:00pm (weather dependent).

**Museum of Science:** March 21 – December 1: daily: 9:00am – one hour before sunset.

**New England Aquarium:** April 1 – December 1: daily: 9:00am – one hour before sunset.

## 7. Boston Children's Museum

General admission to interactive science, history and culture exhibits geared to the younger set.

**Duration:** Approximately 2 hours.

**Getting In:** Present your pass at the front desk for admission.

**Notes:** Children ages 12 months and older will need a pass for admission to the Museum. Children without a pass will be charged the full \$17 retail admission.

**Hours:** Daily: 10:00am – 5:00pm. Friday: open until 9:00pm.

**Closings:** Thanksgiving Day & Christmas Day.

All holiday hours are subject to change without notice.

Take the first left on Dorchester Ave. Follow one block and turn right over the Congress Street Bridge. At the stoplight, turn right onto Congress St. and proceed across the bridge. You'll see the Museum ahead, behind the 40-foot milk bottle. Silver Line to Courthouse Station. Upon exiting, turn left (toward the City of Boston skyline). Walk straight down Seaport Blvd. Cross Sleeper St. and enter the Museum's Children's Wharf Park. Take a left onto the Boston Harborwalk along the Fort Point Channel to the Museum entrance.

## 8. Same-Day Bike Rental by Urban AdvenTours

Same-day standard bike rental including helmet, lock and cable.

**Duration:** All day (return bikes by 6:00pm).

**Getting In:** Plan to arrive at least 30 minutes early to sign a waiver and get sized for a bike.

**Notes:** You may upgrade to an Electric Bike for an additional \$50.00 (payable directly to Urban AdvenTours). Your pass must be valid on the tour day. Alternatively, you may upgrade to the Boston City View Tour, Tour de Cambridge, or Tour de Boston Tour for an additional \$30.00 (payable directly to Urban AdvenTours). Your pass must be valid on the tour day. Child attachments such as baby seats and trailers are available but may be subject to a small surcharge.

**Hours:** Bike rentals are available for the day. Rent and return bikes during the following times. March 16 – October 31:

Monday – Saturday: 9:00am – 6:00pm, Sunday: 9:00am – 5:00pm. November 1 – March 15: Tuesday – Saturday: 9:00am – 6:00pm (closed: Sundays & Mondays).

## 9. Museum of Science

General admission to the exhibit halls with Skipthe-Line entry.

**Duration:** Approximately 2 hours.

**Getting In:** SKIP THE LINE! at the Box Office and proceed to the desk adjacent to the turnstiles for entry. Present your pass for Exhibit Hall admission.

**Notes:** If you would like to purchase tickets for special exhibitions or venues not included with general Exhibit Halls admission (Mugar Omni Theater, Charles Hayden Planetarium, Butterfly Garden, Thrill Ride, or 4D Theater) please go to the Box Office for assistance. Visit [mos.org](http://mos.org) for further details. The Museum is stroller and wheelchair accessible. Please see [mos.org/accessibility](http://mos.org/accessibility) for full details about Accessibility Services available wheelchairs, an assistive listening system, audio labels, and more.

## 10. LEGOLAND® Discovery Center Boston

Single-visit general admission with flex-entry.

**Duration:** Approximately 2.5 hours.

**Getting In:** Proceed to the advanced ticket sales line. Present your pass at the ticket desk for entry.

**Notes:** Adults must be accompanied by a child to enter LEGOLAND® Discovery Center. “Adults-only nights” are not included with your pass.

**Tip:** Like any popular indoor children’s attraction, LEGOLAND® Discovery Center has a limit to the number of guests who may visit at any one time. Massachusetts school vacation weeks often reach capacity. For the most enjoyable experience, we recommend that you visit later in the afternoon rather than first thing in the morning. Weekdays are also quieter than weekends.

## 11. Skywalk Observatory

Admission to Boston's only sky-high vantage point for sweeping 360-degree views of Greater Boston and beyond.

**Duration:** Approximately 45 minutes.

**Getting In:** To access the Skywalk, enter through the Lower Lobby of the Prudential Center (800 Boylston Street) – look for the sign that says Skywalk in the Belvidere Arcade. Proceed down the escalator in front of the Prudential Tower, turn left and take the elevator to the 50th floor. Exit the elevator and present your pass at the ticket desk. Enjoy the View!

**Notes:** Please be advised that the Skywalk Observatory is also a banquet facility. The 360 degree view may not always be available and the Skywalk Observatory does occasionally close for private functions or inclement weather. We recommend calling ahead to ensure that they are open during the time you wish to visit.

**Hours:** Wednesday – Monday: 11:00am – 5:00pm (last admission: 4:30pm), Thursday: 11:00am – 9:00pm (last admission:

8:30pm).

**Closings:** Tuesdays, Patriots Day, July 4, Thanksgiving Day & Christmas Day. All holiday hours are subject to change without notice.

## 14. Fenway Park Tour

Standard ballpark tour of "America's Most Beloved Ballpark", the home of the 2018 World Series Champion Boston Red Sox.

**Duration:** Approximately 1 hour.

**Getting In:** Present your pass at the Gate D ticket booth at the corner of Jersey and Van Ness Streets or the main ticket office (located at the corner of Jersey Street and Brookline Avenue).

**Notes:** Your pass is accepted on all standard ballpark tours. Standard tours run throughout the day, but end 3 hours before game time on game days. Please plan accordingly. The Batting Practice Tour, Game Day Premium Tour and Pre-Game Tour are not included. All stops are subject to availability.

**Hours:** Out of season: 10:00am – 5:00pm.

Non-game days: 9:00am – 5:00pm.

Game days: 9:00am – 4 hours prior to game start.

**Closings:** Christmas Day & New Year's Day. May be closed due special events; please call no earlier than 2 weeks in advance for up-to-date schedule.

## 15. Harvard Museum of Natural History

General admission ticket (valid for single same-day entry) to view impressive botanical, zoological, mineralogical and geological collections on the grounds of Harvard University.

**Duration:** Approximately 1.5 hours.

**Getting In:** Please present your pass to any ticket taker for entry.

**Notes:** Includes same-day general admission to both the Harvard Museum of Natural History and the Peabody Museum of Archaeology & Ethnology.

**Hours:** Daily: 9:00am – 5:00pm.

**Closings:** Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Eve, Christmas Day & New Year's Day.

## 16. Peabody Museum of Archaeology & Ethnology

General admission ticket (valid for single sameday entry) to view one of the world's finest collections of human cultural history on the grounds of Harvard University.

**Duration:** Approximately 1.5 hours.

**Getting In:** Present your pass at the admission desk.

**Notes:** Includes same-day general admission to both the Peabody Museum of Archaeology & Ethnology and the Harvard Museum of Natural History.

**Hours:** Daily: 9:00am – 5:00pm.

**Closings:** Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day & New Year's Day.

## 18. Edward M. Kennedy Institute for the United States Senate

**Duration:** Approximately 1.5 hours.

**Getting In:** Present your pass at the admission desk.

**Notes:** The following groups always receive free general admission:

All children ages 6 and under; Massachusetts residents ages 17 and under; U.S. Active Duty Armed Forces.



If you fit any of the criteria above you will not need to have your pass scanned for admission, but you will be asked to provide a valid I.D. upon entry.

**Hours:** April 1 – September 30: Monday – Friday: 10:00am – 5:00pm, Saturdays, Sundays & holidays: 10:00am – 6:00pm. October 1 – March 31: daily: 10:00am – 4:00pm.

## 20. Salem Witch Museum

General admission to a live reenactment of the Salem Witch Hunt, and exhibits exploring the history of the Salem Witch Trials and the nature of witchcraft today.

**Duration:** Approximately 45 minutes.

**Getting In:** Upon arrival, present your pass at the ticket desk for entry. October: plan to arrive before noon to secure tickets.

**Notes:** Presentations run on the half hour and are offered on a first-come, first-served basis. In October, tickets to the Salem Witch Museum often sell out early in the day. Although lines move quickly, please plan on arriving by noon to check in at the admission desk and secure tickets.

**Hours:** Daily: 10:00am – 5:30pm. Extended hours in July & August.
