1. Hop-On Hop-Off Big Bus San Francisco

Classic Tour: 1-Day Ticket Classic Tour ticket for one day – one of the best ways to get to know the city and see all the top sights from Fisherman's Wharf to the Golden Gate Bridge.

Duration: Approximately 2.5 hours without hopping-off/on.

Getting In: Easy boarding! Hop-on at any Big Bus stop. Show your pass to a Big Bus staff member at any included stop and you're in. Go to www.bigbustours.com/en/san-francisco to download a list of Big Bus stops.

Notes: Children ages 14-years-old and under must be accompanied by an adult while on Zoo grounds. Carousel and train rides are not included with your pass.

22. U.S.S. Hornet Museum

General admission to this national historic landmark moored at historic Alameda Point on San Francisco Bay.

Duration: Approximately 2 hours.

Getting In: Present your pass to any ticket agent for entry. Please note that this site is an old ship; it is always recommended to call ahead regarding unforeseen closures.

Notes: Parking is complimentary with admission. Your pass will not be accepted for entrance for Monster Bash, New Year's Eve Gala, or July 4. For your safety and the security of the Museum, ALL BAGS larger than 12" x 8" x 12" are NOT permitted. This includes backpacks, camera bags, tote bags, diaper bags, ladies purses, etc.

Visitors will be asked to return backpacks and large bags to their vehicle. To accommodate visitors arriving by public transportation, there is a limited supply of rentable lockers.

Directions: From San Francisco: cross the Bay Bridge towards Oakland and follow the signs for 880 South/San Jose/Alameda. Take the Broadway/Alameda exit and turn right at the bottom of the ramp onto 5th Street. Continue on 5th Street, staying on street level. At the Broadway intersection, veer to your left; the Webster Street Tube (tunnel) to Alameda is under the freeway. After emerging from the tube, continue on Webster Street to the first stoplight. Turn right on Atlantic Avenue and continue straight into Alameda Point. Continue to the T-intersection at the water. Turn left onto Ferry Point and proceed towards the cluster of large ships.

Public Transit: By Ferry: take the Blue and Gold ferry, departing from Fisherman's Wharf, to Alameda Ferry terminal. Connect to AC Transit bus #63, which takes you less than a 15 minute walk (3/4th of a mile) from HORNET's Pier. Your ferry ticket comes with a free transfer for the bus. By BART: take BART to Oakland's 12th Street station (weekdays) or Fruitvale station (weekends) and transfer to AC Transit bus #63.

23. Six Flags Discovery Kingdom

General admission to this 135-acre theme park which combines marine life, wildlife & wild rides.
