

Asiatique

Asiatique the Riverfront was an old port of East Asiatic Co., Ltd. owned by Danish, exporting goods from Asia to Europe since the period of King Rama V. The warehouse was later turned into the first riverside shopping arcades where you can visit for fine dining restaurants and shopping from more than 1000 shops.

Baan Pad Thai

One of restaurants under Issaya Siamese Club's restaurants, awarded Bib Gourmand from Michelin in 2018 for value of money. Not only original Pad Thai will be served but also varieties of additional ingredients namely fresh water prawn, grilled crab, grilled pork and grilled chicken which can be topped up to your Pad Thai. Vegetarian Pad Thai is also available for vegans. The secret of special recipe is its specialties sauce made from more than 18 ingredients to suit all tastes. Kale wrap and fried dry beef is also strongly recommended.




CBD ROUTE

This route is ideal for exploring the vibrant life that Bangkok is so well known for. Our Siam Hop bus will drive you through both Siam Road, the present-day commercial business district of Bangkok, as well as the old Charoen Krung Road which, over 150 years ago, was the first paved road in the city. Asiatique's facilities and lovely riverside restaurants is a 'must' for visitors to Bangkok. Using Siam Hop Pass in the early evening is the perfect way to get there. Bangkok's newest landmark, the Mahanakorn Building, where you will be mesmerized by the incredible views from Bangkok's tallest building, is also our recommended HOP STOP along this route.

Wat Benjamabophit

It is said to be the best well-planned temple decorated with the best marble slabs from Carrara and Genoa, Italy. Hence, the name Marble Temple. It was commissioned by King Rama V. The main Buddha image is a copy of Phra Buddha Chinnarat from Phra Pravitana Mahathat Temple, Phitsanulok Province (known as Muang Song Kaew or city of 2 rivers).

Giant Swing

Giant Swing was built in King Rama I's reign before being moved to the city courtyard during King Rama V's and remains there until today. This towering red swing was built for Giant Swing ceremony, a Brahman New Year celebration known as Triyumphawai during December - January. According to Brahman belief, Vishnu would descend from heaven to earth for 10 days. Eventually, during Rama VII's reign, the ceremony was cancelled but the Giant Swing still stands tall.

HERITAGE ROUTE

Highlights along this route are many historical places in Bangkok that can be explored from day to night. Colonial style buildings are a significant part of the landscape in this area. First settled on the east side of the mighty Chao Phraya River, this is where the Royal Grand Palace & the Emerald Buddha Temple can be found. Many famous temples, including Wat Trimitr (The Golden Buddha), Wat Pho (The Reclining Buddha), Wat Suthat (The Giant Swing), Wat Ratchanadda (The Metal Castle) and Wat Benjamabophit (The Marble Temple) and much more can be visited with our Siam Hop Pass.




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

Phaya Thai Palace




